Lutheran Services Florida (LSF) helps adolescents live healthier lives and remain out of the juvenile justice system through our prevention and intervention activities. Programs include: short-term, residential shelters for runaways and troubled youth, ages 10-17, as well as individual and family counseling. LSF has an estimated 98 percent success rate of youth returning home to their families to rebuild their lives, following their stay at our shelters.
