Lutheran Services in America—one of the nation’s largest networks of health and human service providers—is rooted in a century-long, faith-based commitment to service. Its 300 nonprofit organizations operate in 1,400 communities across 46 states, Washington, D.C., and the U.S. Virgin Islands, reaching more than 7 million people each year. Together, they improve outcomes for children, youth, and families; support independence for older adults; champion meaningful services for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities; and strengthen stability and purpose for veterans and others.
